- District** Olentangy Local School District, located in southern Delaware County, covers 95 square miles and remains one of the fastest growing districts in Ohio and in the nation. The district is rated "Excellent with Distinction" by the State of Ohio; this is Ohio's highest rating for its public school districts. The district opened its third high school, Orange High School, in 2008-09 as a result of rapidly growing enrollment.
- School & Faculty** Liberty High School is a four-year public high school (grades 9-12) with a present enrollment of 1514 students. There are 378 students in the current senior class. Liberty High School is rated "Excellent" by the State of Ohio Department of Education; this is Ohio's highest rating for its public high schools. Liberty High School has 105 certified staff. Of these, 76.1% have earned a Master's degree or beyond.
- Graduation Requirements** The curriculum at Liberty High School is comprehensive including advanced placement, honors, occupational, and vocational programs. For the graduating class of 2010, twenty-one credits will be required. Specific requirements include elective courses and the following required course of study:

- Honors & Advanced Placement Courses** Honors courses are available in Algebra II, Geometry, and Pre-Calculus, Biology, Chemistry, Physical Science and Physics, French V, German V and Spanish V, and in Interdisciplinary Studies (combining tenth grade advanced English and tenth grade advanced World Studies). Advanced Placement courses are offered in Art History, English Literature and English Composition, American Government/Politics, American History, European History, Macroeconomics, Microeconomics and Psychology, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, and Statistics, and in Biology, Chemistry, Physics C: Mechanics, and Music Theory. Each instructor's syllabus has been audited and approved by the College Board. Advanced Placement courses are weighted on a 5.0 scale. Honors courses are not weighted.
