Free and reduced lunch program applications are available on line or at any of the school offices. You may apply any time during the school year.

- Parents are encouraged to prepay for lunches. If paying by check please reference your child's full name on the check.
- Olentangy Local Schools participates in the National School Lunch Program. The meal includes a meat or meat substitute (entrée), two bread equivalents, a vegetable, a fruit and a milk. Students must select three of these meal components daily, but are not required to take all five.
- Alternate entrées including options for special dietary needs are offered daily. Please contact your cafeteria manager regarding any medically- certified dietary restrictions.
- Milk, fresh fruit, fruit juice, water and daily menu items are available for purchase with cash or debit cards for grades 2 through 5.
- A Snack Wise cart is available at the end of the lunch period for grades 2 through 5, and on Friday's for all grades, however students must have cash to purchase these items. Cart selections are labeled according to Nationwide Children's Hospital's Snack Wise program rating guide. All items offered are in compliance with the USDA guidelines for foods offered for sale.
- Please note: Olentangy Local Schools cannot guarantee the absence of trace amounts of potential allergens not listed on food labels.
- Menus are subject to change due to availability of foods or unplanned school closings.
