### **Physical Education**

**Tuition:** \$200

**Credit:** .25

**Location/Dates/Times:** Virtually, with an introductory meeting Thursday, May 31<sup>st</sup>, at 7:00 at OOHS. to discuss course requirements and to show student how to navigate Schoology. Final exam is July 26<sup>th</sup>.

*Online PE requires students to submit weekly activity logs via Schoology. The students need to have activity from the following four areas: fitness (30 hrs.), team sports (10 hrs.), dual sports (10 hrs.) and individual sports (10 hrs.). Hours are to be recorded at regular intervals. Students will have a written assessment at the end of the semester that they will also submit online. Students are required to perform 5 fitness assessments conducted by the instructor as part of their final exam on July 26<sup>th</sup>.*

#### **LifeTime Fitness PE I**

**Tuition:** \$320

**Credit:** .25

**Location:** Classes meet off-campus

**Dates/Times:** Varies throughout May and June\*

*Students who take this class will complete their PE I requirement for high school. **Attendance at all classes is mandatory.** Activities include canoeing, white-water rafting, hiking, ice skating, bowling, ballroom dance, fitness, scuba diving, and golfing. Class dates will not conflict with 8<sup>th</sup>-grade Washington D.C. trips.*

#### **LifeTime Fitness PE II**

**Tuition:** \$320

**Credit:** .25

**Location:** Classes meet off-campus

**Dates/Times:** Varies throughout May and June\*

*Students who take this class will complete their PE II requirement for high school. **An explanation of the Olentangy Physical Education Waiver:**

In accordance to Section 3313.603 of the Ohio Revised Code, students in grades 9-11 may be excused from all physical education course requirements by participating in District-sponsored interscholastic athletics, marching band, cheerleading, or JROTC for at least two seasons (or two full years for JROTC). Students in grade 12 who have not completed the waiver requirements or taken a physical education course, will be automatically enrolled in physical education their senior year. The Olentangy Local School board shall not require the student to participate in a physical education course as a condition to graduate. However, the student shall be required to complete one half-unit, consisting of at least 60 hours of instruction, in another course of study. Eligible students must complete the district PE Waiver Intent form before the start of the activity season. Forms are available at the District Central Office, high school guidance office, or on the district website.
