 - List of potential elective courses
 - Can choose any course to complete schedule
 - Pre-requisites on some courses

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY: The scheduling process should be a team effort involving the student, their teachers, and the parent(s). We want students to have the most appropriate course selections that both challenge them academically and best prepare them for the future.

From the time a student returns the attached course request sheet (January) until the end of the school year (May), a student may request a change pending course availability by completing a schedule change request form with their counselor.

****It is imperative that the student and parent(s) discuss the scheduled selections carefully to ensure that the course requests best reflect:**

- The Core courses for which the student was recommended
- A firm commitment to complete summer assignments for all AP courses
- A realistic view of how motivated and diligent the student will be in completing academic work next year
- The extracurricular activities, jobs, and other time commitments outside of school

- ❑ Discuss courses that are best for YOU and your interests

THE SCHEDULING PROCESS

➤ **STEP 2: Student Requests**

- Fill in course requests on the Schedule Request Sheet (Blue, Yellow, Green)
 - Start with Core Courses
 - Electives second

- Fill in at least 2 alternate elective courses

THE SCHEDULE REQUEST SHEET

➤ Key Points to Remember:

- Do NOT leave a spot for lunch
- **One** Study Hall per Semester
- At Least 5 periods of classes
 - Study Hall & Student Aide do NOT count
- Elective Options:
 - Art, Business, Family & Consumer Science, Industrial Tech., Performing Arts, and World Language
- Athletes: Must pass 5 classes/Sem
 - PE & AP Lab courses do NOT count

THE SCHEDULING PROCESS

➤ **STEP 2: Teacher Recommendations**

- Strongly consider recommendations
- Schedule Request Sheet to Core Teachers to discuss course recommendation
- English, Math, Social Studies, Science & World Languages

THE SCHEDULING PROCESS

➤ **STEP 3: Parent Conversation**

- Share your teacher recommendations with parents
- Discuss & Compare recommendations with courses you want to take
- Make final decisions on courses for next year

THE SCHEDULING PROCESS

➤ **STEP 4: The Scheduling Conference**

- Every student will meet with a counselor for a scheduling conference.
- Students must bring their **COMPLETED** Student Course Request Sheet with the FINAL requests filled in.
- Schedule:
 - 9th: Jan 22 – 25
 - 10th: Jan 28 – Feb 4
 - 11th: Feb 5 – 11

THE SCHEDULING PROCESS

➤ **STEP 5: Course Request Verification**

- ***March 1, 2019***
- Student Requests Closed
- Any adjustments to requests must be made prior to March 1, 2019

➤ **Audition Courses (Choir, Band, Orchestra)**

- Request course on the Schedule Request sheet
- Talk with the specific teacher about when the auditions will take place.

➤ **Schedule Changes**

- **March 1, 2019**
- No schedule changes after this date
- Student schedule may change due to closed courses, courses not offered, etc.
- Counselors will contact student if adjustments need to be made
