

Mentorship I & II

Olentangy Liberty High School

Student Application-**DUE JANUARY 25th, 2019**

*This program is at Liberty and is two class periods on your schedule, either morning or afternoon.

Mentorship is a program that allows juniors and seniors the opportunity to explore career possibilities through interning in the community. Students may choose to take Mentorship for one or two semesters. Teachers may assist in providing information on possible mentorship sites.

Mentorship I is a one semester class, (likely periods 11 and 12.) Students spend the first 5 weeks in class preparing professionally through résumés, learning about professionalism, and other career related topics. For the next 9-10 weeks, students go to their internship sites for 5 hours a week and are released periods 11 and 12, Tuesday through Friday. After the 9-10-week Mentorship placement is complete, students return to the classroom full time to prepare final projects.

Mentorship II is a second semester class (likely periods 11 and 12.) This class allows Mentorship I students the opportunity to explore two additional career interests. Each placement is 8 weeks in length. Students must complete Mentorship I before taking Mentorship II.

You must indicate whether you are signing up for Mentorship I only (one semester-one placement) or Mentorship I AND Mentorship II (one additional semester-two additional placements) on your application. Please also indicate if you are interested in the morning or afternoon class.

Selection for Mentorship is based on the following criteria:

- Completion of all requirements listed below by **January 25th, 2019**
- Recommendations from staff members (You select staff members and contact them)
- Completion of writing prompt indicating your desire to take Mentorship (See Schoology)
- Résumé- If you don't have one, make one!
- Excellent Attendance and Tardy Records
- GPA requirement: 3.3 or above
- Transportation (Students must provide their own transportation to their site)
- No discipline concerns
- Positive Leadership

The following must be completed and returned by **January 25th, 2019** to apply for Mentorship:

1. Join the Schoology Course "Mentorship Applicants 2019" by going to my courses and then adding a course by entering the code-NGZNV-KXDSB.
2. Complete "Application Information" form - Link on Schoology Page
3. Completed writing prompts. (Submit as a word document on Schoology page)
4. Current résumé (Upload as a Word Doc or PDF)
5. Send Recommendation form to 2 teachers
