INDIVIDUAL | FAMILY RESPONSIBILITIES

- STAY HOME IF YOU'RE SICK AND NOTIFY CONTACTS.
- FOLLOW <u>PUBLIC HEALTH RESTRICTIONS</u> IF YOU BECOME A CASE OR A CONTACT.
- WASH & SANITIZE HANDS FREQUENTLY.
- STAY UP TO DATE WITH COVID-19 VACCINATIONS.
- WEAR A WELL-FITTING MASK:
 - IF YOU BECOME A CASE
 - IF YOU BECOME A CONTACT
 - IF A MASK ADVISORY IS IN PLACE
- PARENTS | GUARDIANS: REPORT SICK STUDENT(S) TO THE SCHOOL OR DAYCARE.







DELAWARE PUBLIC HEALTH DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITIES

- INVESTIGATE:
 - OUTBREAKS OR CLUSTERS OF COVID-19 CASES IN HIGH-RISK SETTINGS.
 - OUTBREAKS OR CLUSTERS ASSOCIATED WITH NEW COVID-19 VARIANTS.
 - SEVERE COVID-19 CASES, HOSPITALIZATIONS, AND DEATHS.

- ASSIST PUBLIC WITH GENERAL COVID-19 QUESTIONS.
- CONTINUE MONITORING <u>INFECTIOUS DISEASES</u>.



- ASSIST HEALTH DISTRICT WITH OUTBREAK
 INVESTIGATIONS.
- DAYCARES | SCHOOLS: REPORT COVID-19 CASES TO THE HEALTH DISTRICT.
- SEND HOME STUDENTS AND EMPLOYEES WHO ARE SICK.
- PROMOTE FREQUENT SANITIZING AND HAND WASHING.
