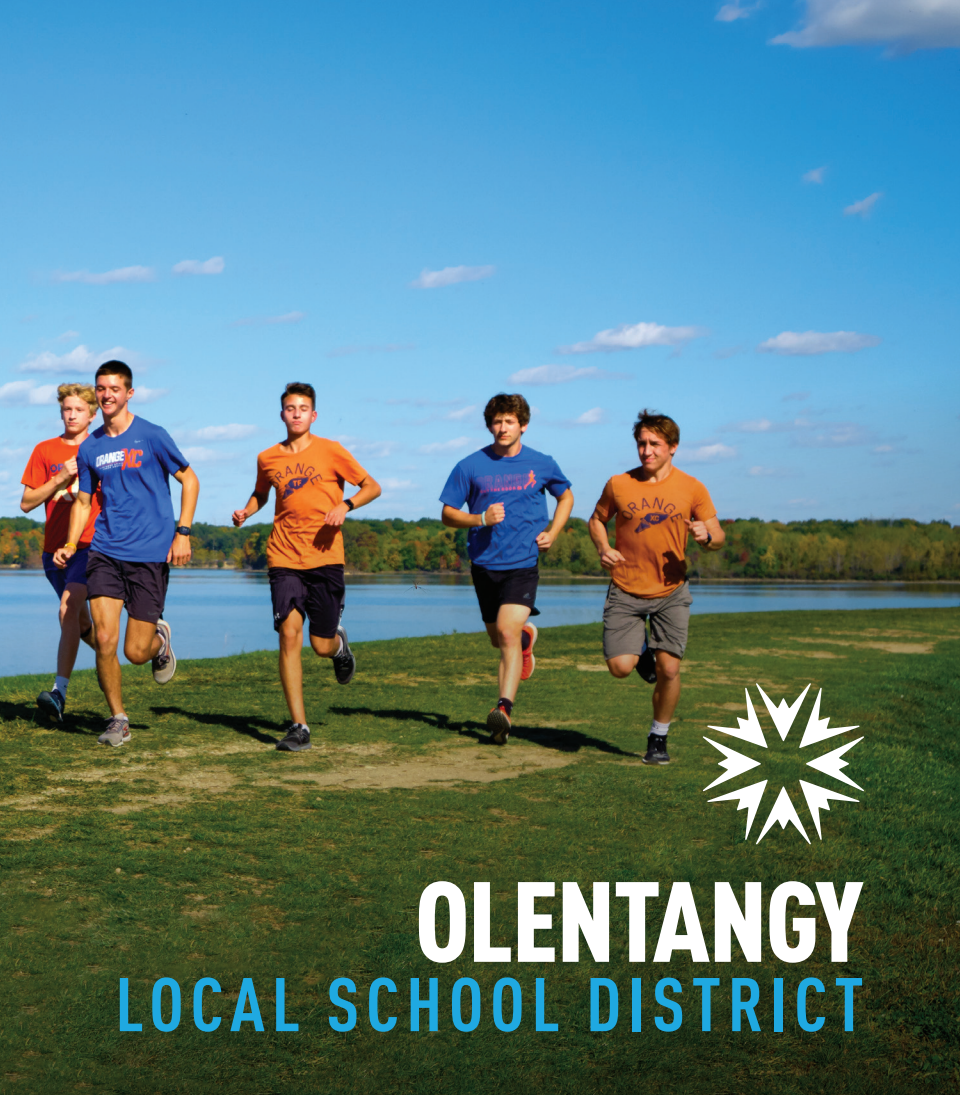

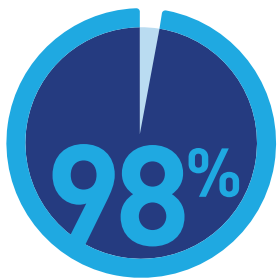

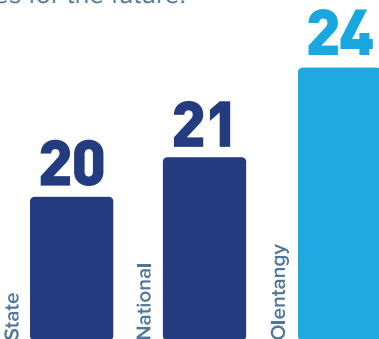

STUDENT WELL-BEING

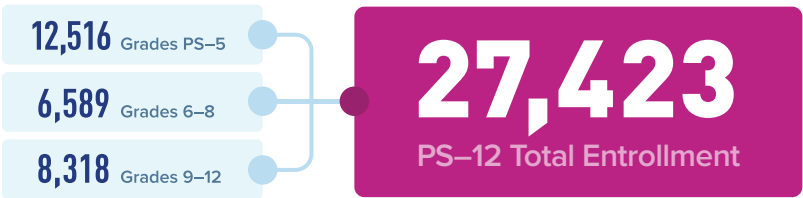

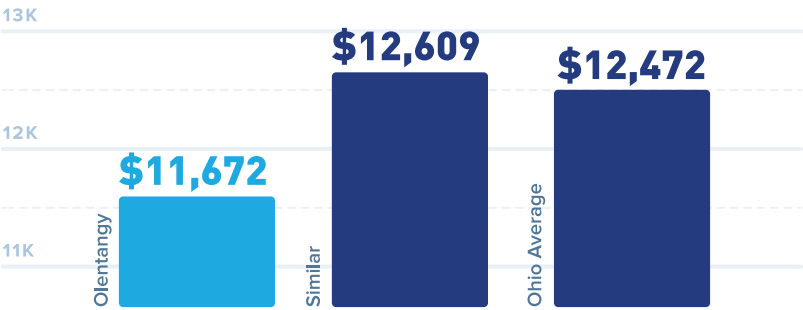
With a vision to be a recognized leader for high performance and efficiency in education, Olentangy continues progress in achieving our strategic priorities.

COST PER PUPIL COMPARISON

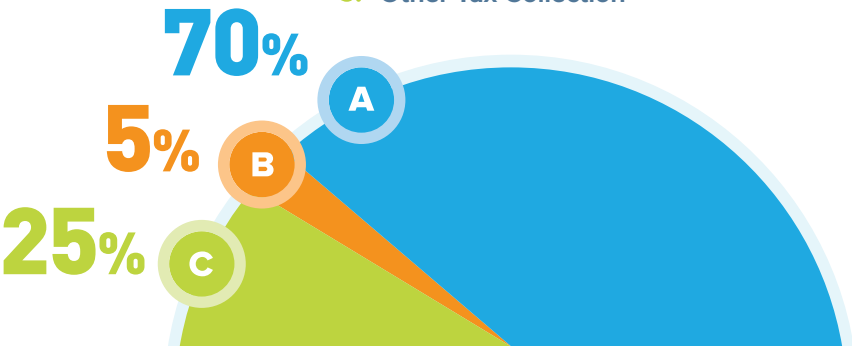


STATE FUNDING
