Olentangy Schools earns the support of our community by being financially responsible without sacrificing academic excellence. By being extremely efficient and deliberate about how we manage our funds, we're able to deliver an exceptional value in public education.

In June 2021, the state of Ohio passed the Fair School Funding plan. The new formula funding is expected to begin December 2021 adding an estimated \$3.5 million in Olentangy's General Fund revenue each year for the next two years.
